Types of Projects

CAREER RESEARCH

1. Shadow

- Student must job shadow a minimum of **20 hours**.
- Student must complete shadowing in blocks of one or more hours.
 - Student may not complete shadowing during school hours unless prior approval is granted.
- Student must shadow one or more professionals and complete the following:
 - *Student Shadowing Record /Personal Reaction Notes* for each visit.
- Student must obtain a signature from the shadowed professional for each visit.

2. Interview

- Student must conduct a minimum of 2 interviews.
- Student must complete a *Shadowing Interview Sheet* for each person shadowed/interviewed.
(Note: If a student shadows only one person, then the student must interview another employee of the same business.)

3. Written Component

- Student will complete and submit a paper that summarizes his/her experience.

4. Oral Presentation (with a visual aid)

COMMUNITY SERVICE

1. Volunteer

- Student must volunteer a minimum of **20 hours**.
 - Excludes class assignments
 - Excludes personal employment
- Student must perform the community service with an organization operating as a service to the community.
- Student must complete the following:
 - *Volunteer Hours Log* with a supervisor's signature verifying the number of hours accumulated for each visit.
 - *Personal Reaction Notes* for each visit.
- Student completing community service hours while on court-ordered probation may not use those hours for his/her graduation project. If a student wishes to continue volunteer work at a community service location where he/she completed court-ordered probation hours, the student must provide proof that the court-ordered hours and the Graduation Project hours do not overlap.

2. Written Component

- Student will complete and submit a paper that summarizes his/her experience.

3. Oral Presentation (with a visual aid)

ACADEMIC EXTENSION

1. Project

- Student must submit a written proposal to the staff member who will supervise the extended learning opportunity and their advisor.
- The Advisor will give final approval for the extended study.
- Student must spend a minimum of **20 hours** working on the project/extended study.
- Student must complete a log of the time spent working on the project.

2. Written Component

- Student will submit a paper that summarizes his/her experience.
